### Packing List:

#### **All items must be labeled with name.**

Mess Kit – a draw string bag containing plate, bowl, mug, cutlery, and a tea-towel  
All meals are provided from Saturday afternoon to Sunday lunch time  
2 x t-shirts ([bring old clothes](#))  
2 x shorts or long pants  
2 x underwear  
2 x socks  
Plastic bag for wet/dirty clothes  
1 x warm jumper or jacket (something suitable for campfire at night, avoid synthetics)  
1 x wide brimmed hat (no caps)  
Handkerchiefs / tissues  
2 x sets of closed in shoes, one set for spare  
No croc/thongs, must be closed in shoes at all times.  
Pajamas or something warm to sleep in  
Sleeping bag  
Pillow  
Self inflating matt / air mattress  
Tent ([Some tents are available to borrow](#))  
Torch  
Towel  
Toiletries – face washer, personal wipes, toothpaste, toothbrush, brush/comb



(The only shower is for emergencies only. Shower when you get home! There are male and female flushing toilets)

Water bottle and Back Pack for day activities  
Sunscreen and insect repellent ([expect mozzies](#))  
Raincoat  
Spending Money – cafeteria and souvenirs available  
Folding Chair for adults

#### Special Items

Cuddley Toy or blanket – to be left in the tent

#### What Not To Bring:

No toys, Ipods, or other electronic games.  
No singlet tops, crop tops, or skirts.  
No lollies, chips, soft drink etc.

**No Alcohol – even though this is not a Scout campsite, it will not be appropriate to drink or smoke around the children**

#### Other Information for Parents/Leaders:

Every person attending the camp must fill in the activity form. Parents must also fill in a PED form.

No alcohol may be brought onto or consumed on the campsite. No smoking around the youth members, or inside buildings.

If your child takes medication regularly – you, the parent will be responsible for medicating your own child. All medication should be stored in a safe and secure location.

Sleeping arrangements – Joeys will be required to sleep in a tent with their parents. Tents are available to borrow if you don't have your own.

Please note that if for any reason you need to leave the campsite before the end of the Camp, you must advise your Joey Leader
